The Saskatoon City Employees Credit Union is proud to announce the award of two **\$1000.00 Scholarships**. Each scholarship will be available to 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th year students and will be awarded annually to a member of our credit union or a member's child or grandchild. The following criteria will apply to the award of this scholarship:

- a) Each scholarship is open to a SCECU member enrolled as a full-time student in a post secondary education program leading to a certificate, diploma or degree at an institution in Saskatchewan registered with the Government of Saskatchewan Ministry of Advanced Education, Employment and Immigration. The program must be a minimum of 8 months in duration.
- b) Each scholarship will be awarded to a member of our Credit Union. If you are currently not a member, and are eligible to become a member (a COS employee or family member of a COS employee) please sign up in-branch or online: https://www.scecu.com

- c) All submissions must include:
 - ⇒ notice of acceptance into educational institution
 - ⇒ official transcript of grades from: Saskatchewan Department of Education; Saskatchewan University; Institute of Applied Science and Technology etc.
 - ⇒ detailed list of applicant's activities and accomplishments over the past five years
